Enhanced Safety Procedures Due to COVID-19

June, 2020

The Phillips Farm Nature Camp staff will be taking precautions following CDC Guidelines and Idaho Governor Little's recommendations for the safety and health of all participants.

Staff members will be:

- 1. Urging the frequent use of the hand washing station provided by the camp.
- 2. Wearing either a mask or face shield. (Campers themselves are not required to wear masks, but they are welcome to do so if they wish)
- 3. Cleaning/disinfecting surfaces
- 4. Encouraging social distancing by recommending spacing between participants and creating small groups
- 5. Limiting the sharing of items by providing enough materials for each participant to use
- 6. Providing hand sanitizer before and after all snacks and lunch or when deemed appropriate.
- Screening all participants with a non-contact infrared thermometer. The CDC considers a person to have a fever when he or she has measured temperature of 100.4°F (38°C). If anyone has a fever, they will be sent home.
- Trained on all safety actions listed above. In addition, the camp leaders (Educational Coordinator and Assistant Educational Coordinator) have certificates in Adult/Child First Aid and CPR.
